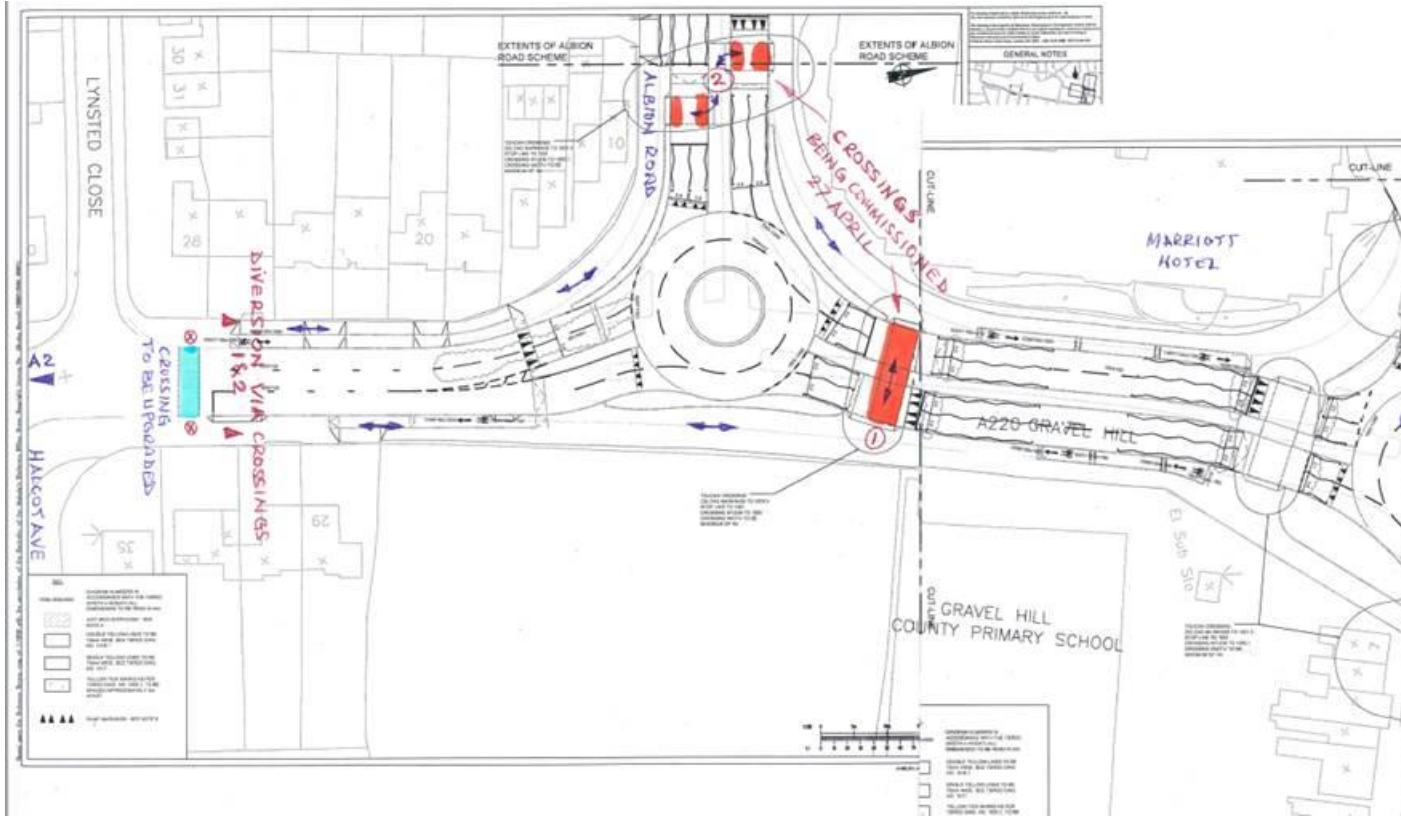


Subject: Bexleyheath Town Centre Revitalisation Phase 2 Stage 2 - pedestrian crossing on Gravel Hill at Halcot Avenue

The Transport for London contractor has almost finished installing the new crossing signals at the end of Albion Road. These will be commissioned on the morning of Friday 27 April. On Friday afternoon the existing signals at the crossing near Halcot Avenue will be de-commissioned to allow them to be up-graded. This will be a short term operation and the new signals will be commissioned on Tuesday morning (1 May). For this short period pedestrians will be directed to cross using the newly installed signals at the pedestrian crossing immediately above the Albion Road roundabout.



This means that the existing crossing near Halcot Avenue will not be operating when the schools end on Friday, during Monday or when the schools are opening on Tuesday and parents and children should follow the diversions which will be indicated by signs.

I apologise for the short notice but the programme has only just been determined by TfL.
